Candidates may submit a policy statement of not more than 200 words in support of their nomination. The statement may include a photograph of the nominee.

The photograph and policy statement must be submitted with the candidate's nomination.

Election Regulations

Ballot Paper Draw

Draws to determine the order of candidates' names on the ballot paper will be conducted by the Returning Officer at 12:00 noon on Thursday, 9 September 2010 at the offices of MONSU Peninsula.

Request to Register Name of Group

Requests for the registration of a name of a group must be submitted to reach the Returning Officer no later than 12:00 noon on Thursday, 9 September 2010.
