4.1 IHRA Definition - Guest Speaker

Ruthie Brown identifies as Jewish and has come to the Student Council to ask that they adopt

the all inclusive IHRA definition of Anti Semitism.

Definition:

"Anti Semitism is a certain perception of Jews, which may be expressed as hatred toward Jews.

Rhetorical and physical manifestations of antisemitism are directed toward Jewish or

non-Jewish individuals and/or their property, toward Jewish community institutions and religious facilities"

Ruthie states that there are issues with the socialist groups on campus and that there is a culture embedded within the Monash community. However, the University will not remove the socialists due to free speech. The Student Council is in support of the definition to show support to minorities on campus so that they feel safe and supported.
