



Assessment tasks are set to demonstrate you have achieved the learning outcomes of the units. Usually, you have one chance to complete each assessment task or exam.

If you can't complete an assessment task or exam due to exceptional circumstances beyond your control, you may be eligible for special consideration. If granted, you may be given an extension, another assessment or a deferred exam, but your original assessment result can't be changed
