Financial assistance with costs associated with going on placement

e.g. accommodation, transport, immunisations

The MONSU Peninsula Placement Relief Fund provides financial support to students facing costs associated with placement, such as accommodation, transport, and immunisations.

We understand that going on placement can bring added financial pressure, this fund is here to help ease that burden. Students can apply once per semester for a **\$250 payment**, unless unexpected or extenuating circumstances apply.

Please note, funding is limited and subject to availability.

How to apply:

1. Check that you have read and agree with the eligibility terms & conditions before applying (see below).
2. Ensure that you have [logged in](#) to the MONSU Peninsula website then proceed to complete all sections of this form.
3. Provide the supporting documentation including proof of placement, all relevant receipts and current bank account balance. You may be asked to provide additional evidence where required.

- Domestic student applicants must be enrolled in Paramedicine, Occupational Therapy or Physiotherapy courses
- Domestic students from Nursing, Midwifery and Education courses who are ineligible for CPP are welcome to apply for the MONSU Placement Relief Fund.
- If a HECS HELP-liable student, have deferred in full their HELP loan payment
- If the holder of a student visa, be able to demonstrate an unexpected change in financial circumstances since commencing the program of study
- Be able to demonstrate financial need
- Not be in receipt of a substantial scholarship, bursary or grant
